Call to Order – J. Christensen at 1:30 pm

- a. Approved SGT Minutes from Nov. 10, 2020 (Sabeh moved; Spear-Barrett seconded)
- b. Reviewed membership; confidentiality expectations will be noted during meetings, if needed.

1. **Old Business** – Principal Sabins

- a. "Marauder 5" Weekly Edition 10-minute videos to help reconnect students to school will be supervised by J. Ernest as soon as youth can be on campus
- b. Phase 2 Construction Update bids will be solicited in February for a contractor. Detailed construction plans are not yet available for viewing. Set to break ground within one year from now, with construction planned for up to 24 months (or three years total).
 - i. Building 100 for World Languages 8 classrooms with restrooms, including gender-neutral.
 - ii. Building 900 (two floors)
 - 1. First Floor: foyer with open seating for informal gathering; locked, single point of entry with security check-in (district wide); campus police office; expanded health office for transport privacy considerations; administrative offices, including streamlined student records location.

- 2. Second Floor: 18 classrooms and offices.
- iii. Baseball Field upgrade to start after the end of the 2021 season.
- iv. Additional upgrades: lunch seating structures, concrete hardscape, and the Marauders Mural (by the home bleachers).
- c. Phase 3 Performing Arts Center Building
- d. Phase 4 Athletics (secondary gym and outdoor spaces)
- e. Q/A Responses
 - i. New Track will be installed soon due to safety concerns.
 - ii. Recent tagging on upper field two weeks ago was promptly repainted by the district.
 - iii. Possibility of HD camera system, esp. on upper field.
 - 1. Desirable: secondary camera systems with professional installation in new buildings with low staff/ high student ratio such as VPA buildings.
 - iv. Air-conditioning repair in the 600 building.
 - v. Elevator replacement in the 600 building will be needed costly to repair the current structure.
 - vi. Entrance/ parking/ "curb cut" issues with Mark Twain.
 - vii. Additional parking for MMHS confirmed; electrical vehicle parking desirable.
 - viii. No new solar panels because MMHS is 90% off the grid.

2. New Business

- a. Principal Sabins
 - i. Proposal development with area principals is underway for the return of in-campus learning, currently anticipated for Fall 2021 with a 6-period, full-day schedule.
 - 1. Flexibility in these areas: daily student attendance (virtual and/or in-person); weekly schedule options for sites based partly on school size; and covid-19 testing/ vaccination options for students.

- ii. Vaccines for educators in SD Unified will be a County decision, as part of the 1B roll-out.
- iii. Multiple graduation ceremonies for seniors may be possible if students can return to campus in Qtr. 4 (after Spring Break) and the county's status in the tier system is acceptable.

iv. Q/A Responses

- 1. Status of walking bridge over Mira Mesa Blvd. that connects the high school to the park will cost \$12 million and needs a height clearance. Also possible is making the bridge a "Mira Mesa" archway sign over the boulevard similar to signage in other San Diego City neighborhoods.
- 2. Cohort scheduling is tricky at large sites like MMHS because students are at different levels, esp. in terms of electives. Passing periods will be challenging as well.
- 3. For teachers, in-person AND online instruction happening concurrently will be difficult to manage. They will continue to have limited interactions with students inperson, too.
- b. Seniors returning to campus at some point? Laurisa Murray
 - i. Not possible currently. High schools in the district are absolutely concerned about how to recognize seniors for whom the entire year and part of the junior year have been spent off-site and online
- c. Weekend access to classrooms for teachers? Jeanne Christensen
 - i. Follow-up will be available after a meeting that the principal will attend on Feb. 8th.
 - ii. District concerns about liability, social distancing, and regular covid testing on the weekends.
