AP EXAMS

AP testing has been going well. We are coming up on the exams that students will take digitally. Some students have done the digital testing app download and have reached out to Mrs. Blanchard if they had issues. The concern is that not even half of our digital test takers have downloaded the app or launched it. Some students who did this early learned their computer did not support the app. We have been able to resolve this issue, but if students don't do the download early enough, we may not have time to correct this issue, so please encourage your child to do this as soon as possible if they are taking a digital AP exam. - Eligibility: Anyone 12 and older (students, staff, community)
- Clinic Schedule: Tuesday May 18, 2021 from 10:00am 5:00pm. // Second dose will be given Tuesday June 8, 2021. (subject to change due to scheduling).
- Anyone under 18 must have parent consent to get vaccinated- consent forms provided on the next page // Parents are able to come with their students and complete a consent on site if needed.
